Lake Geneva Destinations and Information

Sailing season is about to start. One of the closest and cleanest sailing waters can be found on Geneva Lake (its formal name). Many of us are trailer sailors and would rather anchor out for a night or two instead of just a day sail and the time involved in launching and retrieval.

Geneva Lake allows overnight anchoring per the officers at the Safety Station in Williams Bay, WI. The boat may not be left unattended and lights are required if anchoring outside of the "No Wake" buoys. Lights are not required inside of these buoys. I took advantage of this only once at Williams Bay and anchored by the beach between the "No Swimming" buoys and the "No Wake" buoys. At that time I made prior arrangements with the Fontana launch attendant and Police to leave my car and trailer in the parking by paying the next day's \$18 launch fee in advance. It was a good trade off to get an additional day sailing w/o the retrieval and relaunching procedures.

Car and trailer parking is available at Hansen's Pier, a private 2 acre grassy lot at the Y intersection of E. Geneva St and Laurel St. This is ¾ mile East of the Williams Bay launch ramp. I'll have the phone number and current overnight rates by the April 20th meeting. Last year it was \$10 when I called for info. Google Maps shows the lot on the south side of the intersection.

Fontana and Williams Bay have municipal piers close to launch ramps for short term use while enjoying local restaurants. Fontana has Gordy's and Chucks, W. Bay has Harpoon Willies and Café Calamari. A new upscale restaurant, Pier 290, is part of Gage Marine and has their separate pier on the west part of W. Bay.

The first scheduled combined sail with RYC and NWSA is May 16th. If the weather is favorable I plan on using Hansen's Pier for an overnight car and trailer storage and anchoring out. I hope that several RYC trailer sailors and crew will join in this event. However, please let me know in advance so that we can have enough boat owners and crew for this sail.
