CORN CAKE or CORNBREAD CASSEROLE

- 2 eggs
- 2 cups sour cream
- 1 stick butter melted (ROOM TEMPERATURE)
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 can regular corn with the liquid
- 1 can cream corn
- 2 boxes Jiffy cornbread muffin mix

Beat eggs, add sour cream and beat, stir in melted butter (room temperature), add salt and sugar, stir, add both cans of corn with liquid, add cornbread mixes and stir only enough to mix, lumpy is good. Bake at 350 degrees for one hour.
